The Hinga-Boersma Dean of the Chapel occupies an endowed vice presidential position that is responsible for overseeing the Christian life and formation of Hope College. Hope is a liberal arts college of 3,200 students and 750 employees. Primary responsibilities include working with the President and President's senior cabinet, Board of Trustees, and institutional strategic planning team; administering a voluntary chapel program with four worship services a week that involves preaching regularly in both chapel and the Sunday evening college service called The Gathering, leading and managing a professional ministry team of 10 people, and administering programs related to Christian formation in academics, worship, discipleship, missions and social justice outreach; overseeing departmental budgets and fundraising; nurturing pastoral relationships with students, faculty, and staff in an ecumenical context and in the greater Holland community; as well as public speaking and writing on behalf of the college and the church.

The chaplain at Northwestern College occupied a vice presidential administrative position responsible for leading a campus-wide spiritual life program. In this capacity, the chaplain oversaw daily chapel, local and international outreach efforts, student discipleship programs, teaching and faculty formation for the integration of faith and learning.
